

LOCATION: A portion of Route 28 between George Ryder Road and Barnhill Road in West Chatham.

PROJECT TIMELINE: Approximately 19 months from February, 2013 to the summer of 2014. Important stages along the way include 25% design, 75% design, 100% design and conclude with the creation of Plans, Specifications and Estimate (PS&E) drawings which are used to bid and construct the job.

DESIGN PROJECT COST: Approximately \$382,000

DESIGN PROJECT GOAL: The concept submitted by the Town is aligned with the Town's comprehensive plan and takes the "Complete Streets" approach of slowing traffic on Route 28 while improving conditions for pedestrians and cyclists. The current design phase of the project will take the concept and, working with all stakeholders, make it real so that it can be built.

ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST: Approximately \$3,442,000 (2016 TIP)

ONE OF TWO PROJECTS: The Route 28 Intersections Improvement Project is one of two coordinated, *but separate* projects addressing Route 28. The Intersections Improvement Project deals with rebuilding Route 28 between George Ryder Road and Barn Hill Road. This work is being done by the Town of Chatham and a consultant team led by Howard/Stein-Hudson. The Route 28 Corridor Visioning Project is being done by the Cape Cod Commission under the direction of the Town and addresses streetscaping and land use along Route 28 from Crowell Road to the Harwich town line.

CITIZEN INPUT: While the Town remains committed to positive change on Route 28 in West Chatham, going from a concept to a strong buildable design requires community input. Your comments, questions, and concerns are solicited and welcomed. Our public involvement process is beginning with a public information meeting and office hours during early spring 2013. It also includes a project website (www.wcroadwaydesign.info) and a series of further public information meetings. We look forward to a conversation and partnership with area residents, business owners, community advocates and officials.
